The Munsell hue scale consists of five primary hues (Red, Yellow, Green, Blue, Purple) augmented by five intermediary hues (Yellow-Red, Green-Yellow, Blue-Green, Purple-Blue, Red-Purple) positioned ten hue steps apart, producing 100 equal perceptually spaced hues.

Munsell introduced his system in 1913 with the publication of the Atlas of the Munsell Color System, which featured 15 colour charts consisting of several hundred colour chips arranged according to the three characteristics of hue, value, and chroma.

Munsell in the first decade of the 20th century and adopted by the United States Department of Agriculture as the official color system for soil research in the 1930s.
